Support for Commercially Insured Patients



CO-PAY ASSISTANCE

Eligible, commercially insured patients may pay as little as \$0 per month for oral medicines or per treatment for certain injectable medicines through our co-pay savings programs. [Limits, terms, and conditions apply.](#)*

*For oral products, [click here](#) and for injectable products, [click here](#). Patients are not eligible for these programs if they are enrolled in a state or federally funded insurance program, including but not limited to Medicare, Medicaid, TRICARE, Veterans Affairs health care, a state prescription drug assistance program, or the Government Health Insurance Plan available in Puerto Rico. For oral products, patients may receive up to \$10,000 per product in savings annually. For injectable products, maximum annual patient savings range from \$10,000 to \$25,000.

The Pfizer Patient Assistance Program

If you are not commercially insured, the [Pfizer Patient Assistance Program](#)[†] provides Pfizer medicines for free to eligible patients who are having difficulty affording their prescribed Pfizer Oncology medicines. To be evaluated for assistance, patients must submit a completed Patient Assistance Program Enrollment Form and meet certain requirements.

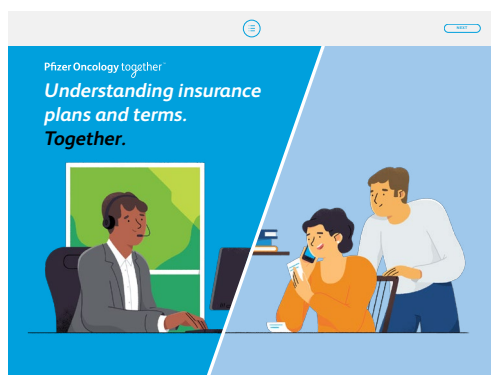

Educational resources covering insurance and financial literacy, as well as caregiver support, workplace transition, and wellness.



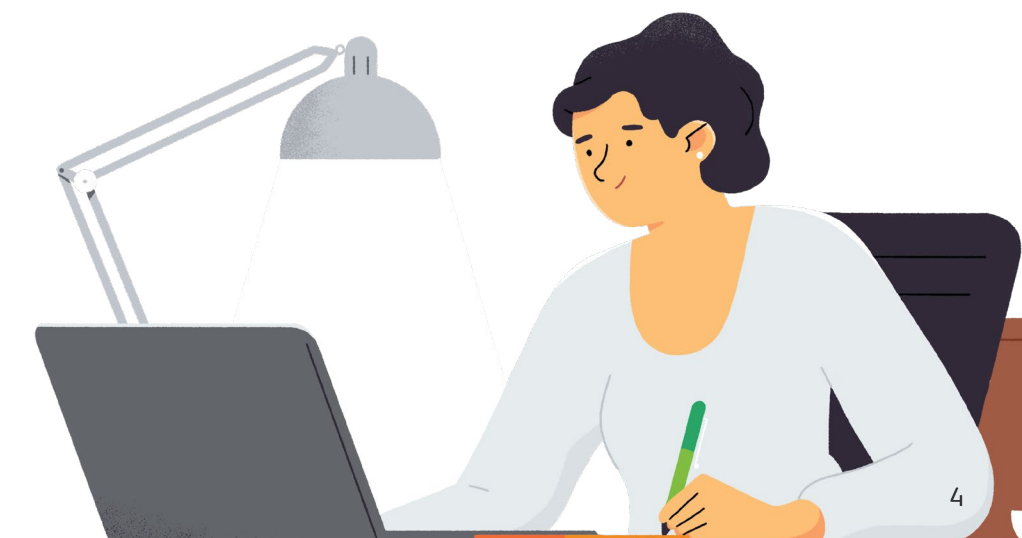
Advocacy organizations that may provide emotional support and education about your type of cancer.
